WHAT: **Chester, PA, May 11, 2015** – This week, 2,500 [Chester Community Charter School \(CCCS\)](#) students will perform and show their creative work at the school's Spring Concert series and art show, over a three-day period. Students in grades kindergarten-through-eighth will perform more than 70 classic songs using 16 different instruments, including piano keyboards, recorders, ukuleles, Orrif instruments, hand drums and other percussions. CCCS' arts and music program is made possible through grants from 21st Century Learning Centers and the Barbara Berry Foundation.

At the school's sports banquet, Jon Breeden, personal trainer and owner of Jon Breeden Enterprises, will share words of wisdom on his athletic success and how he translated it into an entrepreneur opportunity. The recent West Chester University graduate will speak before 62 student-athletes and 175 parents, guardians and community members, at the Clarion Hotel.
